# 2016 REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

Local entrepreneur Charles K. Blandin established his foundation in 1941, and since then the foundation has awarded more than 8,300 grants totaling \$377 million and provides community leadership training and engages rural Minnesota communities on topics such as student success and broadband.

Blandin Foundation grants support vibrant rural Minnesota communities, especially Itasca area communities. At least 60% of grants are dedicated for the Itasca County area, including neighboring communities of Hill City, Remer, Blackduck and Northhome. In addition to the local grants awarded in 2016 (listed below), the Foundation awarded more than \$1,000,000 in scholarships to 338 Itasca area students.
